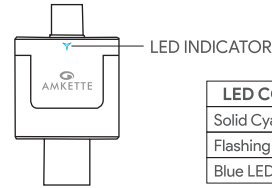

#### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Amkette Drive Cast 2-in-1 Wireless CarPlay Adapter is a compact Wi-Fi & adapter that converts your car's wired CarPlay or Android Auto into a seamless wireless experience. It connects instantly, retains full OEM controls, and keeps your dashboard wire-free.

#### COMPATIBILITY

- Works with cars that have factory-installed wired CarPlay or Android Auto.
- Supports iPhone (iOS 12.1 or above) and Android (Android 10.0 or above).
- Plug & Play with both USB-A and Type-C ports.

#### 15) LED OFF or flickers; adapter restarts randomly

This indicates unstable 5 V power or a charge-only port. Move to the OEM data port, avoid hubs/extenders, and test on a simple 5 V USB charger to confirm stability before reconnecting to the car.

#### 12) Can't reach pairing/connection screens at all

Some cars have multiple USB behaviors; try each OEM smartphone-integration port and avoid extenders. Start car → Insert DriveCast → follow 3-step flow (Plug → Wi-Fi/BT ON → Pair "Amkette DriveCast").

#### 13) Steering-wheel buttons or rotary knob don't control apps

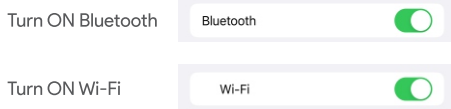
Some head units map controls only after CarPlay/Android Auto fully initializes. Quit and relaunch CarPlay/Android Auto once connected, ensure no other BT audio profile is active, and check the hardware unit's control settings are enabled for smartphone projection.

#### 14) Switching between iPhone and Android is inconsistent

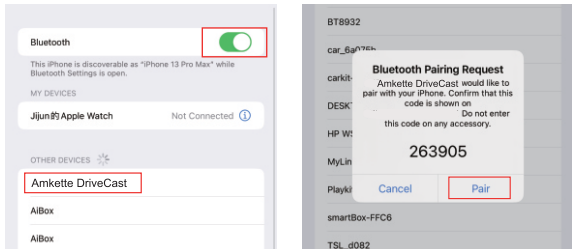
Each phone stores its own pairing profile. Forget DriveCast on both phones (and in the Hardware Unit if listed), then pair the phone you want to prioritize first. On the non-primary phone, keep Bluetooth OFF until the primary completes auto-launch.

#### CONNECTION- APPLE CARPLAY

##### 1. PAIRING



On your iPhone, go to Settings → Bluetooth, and connect to "Amkette DriveCast".



##### 2. CONNECTING

Once paired, the screen will automatically switch to Apple CarPlay (Wireless).



Next time you start your car, DriveCast connects automatically.

#### 8) Head unit restarts or shows "Accessory Not Supported"

Use a direct OEM port (no splitters). Ensure CarPlay/Android Auto is enabled in hardware unit settings and update hardware unit firmware if available.

#### 9) Bluetooth shows connected, but screen stays on home

Delete the pairing on phone and hardware unit, reboot both, then pair again ensuring Wi-Fi remains ON during setup. Avoid connecting to other in-car Bluetooth devices until DriveCast finishes launching.

#### 10) OTA update page doesn't open

Power DriveCast from a simple 5 V USB charger. Connect phone to the adapter's Wi-Fi (see QSG), open 192.168.1101, and turn Mobile Data OFF while updating for a stable session.

#### 11) How do I upload the log data if the adapter doesn't work?

Please enter the IP address page & fill in the car info in the problem description sheet, and press "Submit" to upload your log data.

#### 4) Auto-connect doesn't work next time

On the phone, Forget "Amkette DriveCast" and re-pair. Turn Personal Hotspot/VPN off during reconnection and allow Wi-Fi/BT to run in background (no battery restrictions).

#### 5) Why does the indicator stay on after I switch off the car?

Many vehicles keep the USB/accessory power alive for a short "sleep" period after ignition OFF. During this time, DriveCast's light may remain ON for a few minutes and then shut off automatically. Power draw is very low and will not drain your car's battery.

#### 6) Call issues (low volume / echo / mic not heard)

Raise call volume on the head unit (separate from media). For echo, lower cabin volume a notch and keep the phone away from roof mics; disable voice-altering/noise apps during calls.

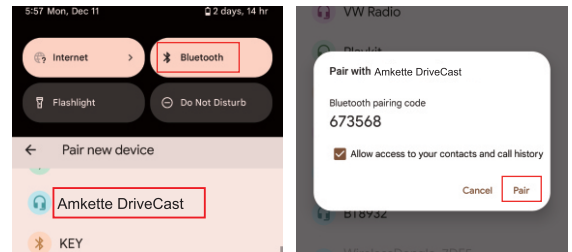
#### 7) Navigation voice missing or too loud

Set Guidance Volume in Maps. Enable Mix with media (if available) so prompts overlay music.

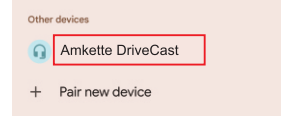
#### CONNECTION- ANDROID AUTO

##### 1. PAIRING

Insert the Amkette DriveCast into your car's USB-A or Type-C data port. Wait for the indicator light to turn on and the device screen to appear on your car display.

##### 2. CONNECTING

Once connected, your car screen will automatically switch to Android Auto (Wireless).



Next time you start your car, DriveCast connects automatically.

#### FIRMWARE UPGRADE (OTA UPDATE)

- Plug DriveCast into any 5 V power source (avoid car data port).
- Connect your phone to the DriveCast Wi-Fi network (Amkette DriveCast, Password: 12345678).
- Open a browser and enter 192.168.1101.
- Select Online Upgrade and wait a few minutes.
- Forget the Wi-Fi network after update completes.

#### TROUBLESHOOTING AND FAQs

##### 1) Car doesn't detect the adapter

Use the OEM data USB/Type-C port (not charge-only), avoid hubs/extenderns, try the other factory port, then restart the head unit and re-insert DriveCast.

##### 2) "Amkette DriveCast" not visible in Bluetooth

Toggle phone Bluetooth OFF → ON, delete old car/adapter entries from the paired list, keep the phone near the console, then scan again.

##### 3) Paired, but CarPlay/Android Auto doesn't start

Wireless projection needs Wi-Fi + Bluetooth. Turn Wi-Fi ON, re-pair, and allow all prompts.  
iPhone: Settings → General → CarPlay → your car → Allow While Locked.

Android: Android Auto → Connected cars → Add new / enable Wireless AA.
